The Voice  
of Truth

The Youth and I are beginning a series on Sunday nights that covers Wisdom in Companions. In our Woven Marriage group, we had a lesson on the importance of being involved in choosing our children's friends as parents. It is vital that we are involved. We as parents must be involved.

One thing we will be talking about tonight is this: First Corinthians 5:9-11 is a direct command from God through Paul that Christians are not to keep company with fellow Christians who are involved in known sin and backsliding. Paul qualifies his command in three ways. 1. He is talking about believers, not unbelievers. 2. He is not talking about complete withdrawal from the world. He does not mean that we are to live like monks in a monastery. If we were not to talk to anyone who has sinned, we would have to withdraw completely from society; we wouldn't even be able to talk to ourselves! He forbids neither our being friendly (courteous and sociable) to the unsaved nor our doing business with them. 3. He is talking about fellowshiping with backslidden believers. Paul indicates clearly that he means keeping company (v. 11) with backsliders. That is the crux of the matter. We can be friendly to them without keeping company with them. We can love them and show that we are interested in them without "eating" with them (v. 11). (The reference to eating has to do with fellowshiping.)
